The meeting was presided over by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, (FCS & CA), Nagaon. After introduction of the members present to the house the ADC welcome to the members present. He stated that public complaints are being received by the office regarding selling of blue dyed SK Oil in the Open market at an exorbitant rate of price and he asked the proprietor of the SK Oil Depots / Sub-Depots to check leakage of SK Oil to the open market from their depot/sub-depot. He further asked that no unauthorized person should be allowed by the SK Oil depot/sub-depot to lift SK Oil on behalf of allottee FP Shops/hawkers/retailers. He stated that the district administration has taken a serious view on the leakage of SK Oil from SK Oil Depot/Sub-Depot and orders are being issued in this regard. He asked the DD, FCS & CA to explain the steps taken by the district administration in this regard and accordingly the DD, FCS & CA elaborately explain the measures proposed to contain the pilferage of SK Oil and streamline the distribution. He also explain the proposal for opening of hawkers point in Nagaon Town.

After threadbare discussion the following steps were decided to rectify and plugged the lacunae in distribution of SK Oil in Nagaon Sadar Sub-Division.

- (1) All SK Oil Depot/Sub-Depot of Nagaon Sadar Sub-Division will henceforth intimate arrival of each load/consignment of SK Oil in their respective depot/sub-depot to the authority over phone or in writing with copy to the concerning area officer.
- (2) The SK Oil Depot/Sub-Depot will not allow un-authorized person to lift SK Oil on behalf of allottee SK Oil retailers/hawkers/FP Shops without approval of the authority.
- (3) All the allottee FP Shops/hawkers/retailers will arrange lifting of allotted SK Oil in container/cart in distinctive yellow colour where name, licence No, price etc. will be displayed in red colour. Carrying of of SK Oil in container/cart other then yellow colour will be treated as illegal.

Minutes of the discussion held with the Rice Millers of Nagaon Sadar Sub-Division regarding milling FCI Paddy, on 17th December'2011 in the Office chamber of Deputy Director, FCS & CA, Nagaon.

The meeting was chaired by the Deputy Director i/c, FCS & CA, Nagaon. At the very outset the DDS wanted to know the delivery position of Paddy to the Rice Mills by FCI for milling out of the last years procured paddy and the picture came out as follows.

The khariff paddy procured during last season has been cleared by the Rice Millers and Rice has already been delivered to FCI.

Out of the Bodo paddy procured last year the Rice mill wise position of lifting paddy from FCI for milling furnished below.

It appears that M/S Sunil Rice Mill of Raha and M/S Maheswari Rice Mill, Raha fails to lift FCI Paddy for milling during last one year.

It is stated by the millers that, FCI does not deliver Paddy to them on actual weighment but use to receive rice on cent percent weighment inflicting loss in weight to the millers. It is also stated by the millers that there should be only 7000-8000 Qtls of Bodo Paddy should be in stock with FCI from last year accounts. After detail discussion the following decisions were arrived at in the meeting.

- (A) All the Rice Millers will lift the remaining Paddy with FCI for milling within a day or two making room for storage for newly procured paddy.
- (B) The FCI authority would be requested to deliver paddy to the millers on actual weighment.
- (C) All the Rice Millers will complete necessary formalities like signing of agreement etc. with FCI for the current khariff season at an early date.

Minutes of the meeting regarding sensitization and awareness on National Iodine Deficiency Disorder Programme held in the Office Chamber of the Addl Deputy Commissioner, (FCS & CA), Nagaon on 23/11/2011.

The meeting was presided over by the Addl. Deputy Commissioner, (FCS & CA), Nagaon. At the outset of the meeting he welcome the members present and read out the recommendation of state level meeting dated 21st of July'2011 on sensitization and awareness. The ADC wanted to know the position of Nagaon District on the general awareness on Iodised salt. The Food Safety Officer present in the meeting briefly explain the steps taken by the health department on the subject and stated that in Nagaon market all salt dealers use to sale iodised salt only. The salt importers present in the meeting also assured that they imports only iodised salt to Nagaon. After threadbare discussion the following decision was arrived at in the meeting.

- (1) All salt importers and salt dealers of Nagaon will submit arrival report of salt in their respective godown immediately after arrival of salt to the district administration with copy to the Food Safety Officer to check iodine content of the salt. In turn the Food Safety Officer alongwith FCS & CA Officers will randomly check the iodine content of the salt in the godown of the respective salt importer/dealer.
- (2) The Food Safety Officer will arrange supply of salt kit for testing of iodine consent of the salt to the district authority at an early date.
- (3) The quality of the iodised salt needs to be checked at grass root level. The Food Safety Officer and Officials under FCS & CA will chalked out programme for check of iodine content of salt with retailers of different corner in the Nagaon Sadar Sub-Division.
- (4) Awareness campaign amongst the consumers are to be made by the department of Health Services and Food, Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs in Nagaon Sadar Sub-Division. The retailers of salt are also to be make aware regarding proper storage of iodised salt. The Food Safety Officer and Supdt, FCS & CA, Nagaon will take necessary steps on the matter with intimation to the undersigned.
